## **Code of Conduct for Committee Members, Officials and Volunteers**

## As a volunteer at the club, we understand you have the right to:

- 1. Enjoy the time you spend with us and be supported in your role
- 2. Be informed of Wavepower and the club child safeguarding reporting procedures
- 3. Know who the welfare officer is
- 4. Be aware of club rules and procedures
- 5. Committee members be involved and contribute towards decisions within the club
- 6. Be respected and treated fairly by the club
- 7. Feel valued welcomed and listened to

## As a volunteer at the club we expect you to:

- 1 At all times, adhere to the Swim England regulations Code of Ethics, club constitution and rules
- 2 At all times, adhere to Wavepower and the clubs safeguarding procedures
- 3 At all times, adhere to the Swim England Equality and Diversity Policy.
- 4 Refer all child safeguarding concerns to the Welfare Officer.
- Adhere fully to the role undertaken as outlined by the club and never use that role to gain favour for yourself or any individual member.
- 6 Consistently display high standards of behaviour
- 7 Treat all members with respect and dignity, value their worth and treat everyone equally, recognising their varying needs and abilities within the context of the sport.
- 8 Encourage and guide members to accept responsibility for their own behaviour and performance.
- 9 Continue to seek and maintain your own development in line with your role and complete a child safeguarding course, if appropriate to your role.
- 10 Treat all information of a personal and private nature about individual members as confidential, except in circumstances where to do so would allow a child to be placed at risk of harm or continue to be at risk of harm.
- 11 Committee members to uphold confidentiality and respect that any item discussed in Committee meetings is private and avoid disclosure to any third party not on the Committee.
- 12 To freely voice his/her opinion on relevant matters
- 13 To bring to the attention of the Committee any recommendations, concerns or complaints passed to them by club members.
- 14 Encourage all members to obey the spirit of the rules and regulations both in and out of the pool.

- 15 Never encourage or condone members, volunteers, officials or parents to violate the rules of the organisation or the sport, and report any violations appropriately.
- 16 Observe the authority and the decision of the officials and only question those decisions in the appropriate manner.
- 17 Treat all competitors and teams of other organisations with respect, whether that is in victory or defeat, and encourage all members to do the same.
